## College Tours

Seeing a campus in person can make all the difference. Each year, The Promise takes students on tours of our Preferred College Partner schools across Pennsylvania. For many, it's their first (and sometimes only) college visit. Promise Ambassadors attend every tour so they can share their experiences with classmates back home.

## Promise College Fairs

The Promise College Fairs are your chance to meet with schools that partner directly with us and provide extra support and funds to Promise Scholars. Our fall fair is for juniors and our spring fair is for seniors who may still be deciding. At our most recent fair, students walked away with over 400 on-the-spot acceptances and more than \$2 million in scholarships. Come ready with questions and explore your options for what's next, including financial aid.

## FAFSA and Financial Aid Support

Paying for college doesn't have to be confusing. The Promise offers FAFSA workshops and one-on-one support to help you and your family complete financial aid forms on time. We'll walk you through scholarships, grants, and other funding options—so you don't leave money on the table.



## Promise Ambassadors

Promise Ambassadors are juniors and seniors who step up as peer leaders in their schools. They help classmates explore post-secondary options, share info about the Promise scholarship, and serve as role models. Ambassadors get paid, receive training from Promise staff, and build skills in communication, organization, and leadership, all things that look great on college and job applications. Ambassadors also receive training to support their peers with FAFSA and financial aid questions.
